# Jackie Robinson Honorary Adult/Youth Baker Format Scholarship Tournament Rules

- 1. ELIGIBILITY:** This Tournament is open to all USBC certified adult and youth bowlers participating in a certified league (including the High School Bowling programs). All youth bowlers participating in this Tournament must present their USBC certification card or a receipt for payment of certification fees at check-in which begins 1 hour before Tournament start time. All bowlers are required to check-in at the designated tournament check-in area at least 1/2 hour prior to the start of the event. Walk-ins will be accepted if space is available. Bowlers arriving late will begin bowling in the frame currently being bowled and shall receive a zero (0) for any frames missed.
- 2. FORMAT:** This is a handicapped or scratch event with 2 members per team. The Baker Format will be used. In this format, each bowler bowls every other frame of every game with each bowler bowling at least 5 frames per game. Teams will bowl 4 games. Youth bowlers will start the 1st and 2nd games and the adult will start the 3rd and 4th games. Substitutions must be verified and authorized by a tournament official. Ties for any qualifying position will be broken by a 9th & 10th frame roll-off with each bowler rolling 1 frame. If a tie still exists, 9th & 10th frame roll-offs will continue to be bowled until a winner is determined. Winners will be determined by total pin fall in the Elite divisions or plus handicap in the handicap divisions.
- 3. AVERAGES:** All Bowlers will use their highest 2016/17 USBC certified league season average with a minimum of 21 games. If the bowler does not have a 2016/17 USBC certified average, he/she will use their current average. If the adult bowler does not have an average, they will be entered into the Elite Division. All averages must be able to be verified. Tournament officials have the right to re-rate all bowlers.
- 4. HANDICAP:** Handicap used will be 100% of the difference between the Adult/Youth combined average and 440.
- 5. ENTRY FEE:** This Tournament is for scholarship competition points only. Entry fee will be \$22.00 per team (1 Adult & 1 Youth) if paid by October 9, 2017. After October 9, 2017, the entry fee will be \$27.00 for each Adult/Youth team. Bowlers who have pre-paid must bring their payment receipt to check-in as well as their certification card. The entry fee will be divided as follows:

Bowling: \$ 11.00	Scholarship Contribution: \$9.00	Expenses: \$2.00	Total: \$ 22.00
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The additional \$5.00 fee for entries received after October 9, 2017 will be added to the Scholarship Fund.

Entry fee can be paid by check, cash, MasterCard, Visa, American Express or Discover. Checks should be made out to: VEI, Inc. with "Jackie Robinson Adult/Youth Tournament" in the note line at the bottom or the check and can be mailed to Skore Lanes, 22255 Ecorse Road, Taylor, MI 48180. Mailed entries will be accepted through October 9, 2017. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for all returned checks. Entry fee refunds will not be made unless a written notice of cancellation is received by October 1, 2017.
- 6. DIVISIONS:** Bowlers will bowl in one of the following divisions: Adult/Boys age 10 and under, Adult/Boys 11-14, Adult/Boys age 15 and over, Adult/Girls age 10 and under, Adult/Girls age 11-14, Adult/Girls age 15 and over, Adult/Youth Elite Scratch Division: Adult/Youth Boys & Girls age 14 and under, Adult/Youth Boys age 15 and older, Adult/Youth Girls age 15 & older. Age of participants is based on actual age as of October 1, 2017.
- 7. SCHOLARSHIP:** The amount of scholarship points awarded will be based on the number of actual participants in the event. The USBC SMART program and the Michigan Bowling Scholarship Fund Committee will administer the Scholarship Fund.
- 8. Only bowlers, designated scorekeepers and Tournament Officials are allowed in the bowler's area during the Tournament. If a problem arises, all bowlers on the pair of lanes in question are to stop bowling and IMMEDIATELY call a Tournament Official. All score corrections and problems require a Tournament Official to be present. Chairs and tables closest to the lanes belong to the bowling athletes.**
- 9. A code of conduct will be posted for parents and bowlers to abide by. Failure to follow this code can be grounds for disqualification of the bowler from the Tournament.**
- 10. ATTIRE:** Proper attire is required for participation in the Tournament. Jeans and tee-shirts (no offensive language permitted) are permitted. Baggy pants, jeans with holes, hats and short skirts are not permitted. In addition, no I-Pods, MP3's, gaming or cell phones are permitted during bowling.
- 11. SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY:** Qualification for a potential scholarship is based upon the following items: Cumulative GPA at graduation, ACT/SAT scores, bowling achievement, and community service. A student must apply to the Michigan Bowling Scholarship Committee providing the proper submitted documents. Once the committee has reviewed the qualifying criteria, a scholarship may be awarded. Points will be tracked on the Michigan Bowling Scholarship website. Future information is available from the Michigan State Youth Bowling website.
