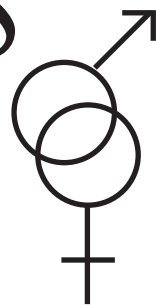

BATTLE OF THE SEXES

1. This league will bowl every Thursday at 7:30 pm for 15 weeks beginning May 10, 2018.
2. The league will consist of 2 divisions, teams of ladies & teams of men. Teams will consist of 4 bowlers with a 5th and 6th person. No new bowlers will be added on the last three weeks of the season. Bowlers must have a minimum of 6 games to bowl in the championship roll-off on week 15.
3. Teams will bowl men vs. women every week except weeks 7 & 14 which will be position rounds within your own division. Week 15 will be the championship rolloff with the 1st place mens team bowling the 1st place womens team to determine the club champion. All other teams will bowl a position round, men vs. women for prize money.
4. The handicap will be as follows: 95% from 225 for the ladies, 90% from 225 for the men.
5. The league will use the 7 point system: 2 points for each game, 1 point for totals.
6. The cost per bowler per week will be \$17.00. Absent bowlers will pay the full amount. The last 2 weeks of bowling must be paid by the 7th week.
7. Entering average for those who participated in the Battle of the Sexes in 2017 will be your final average from last year's Battle. Entering average for those who did not bowl in the Battle of the Sexes last year will be the highest bowl.com average from the last 2 years. Bowlers with no averages will use the blind score of 150 for men, and 120 for ladies. Everyone will establish a league average after 6 games. Teams that do not have a full team on 1st night must use the blind score. **THE 10 PIN DROP RULE WILL BE USED.** Under the 10 pin drop rule, special consideration will be given to all bowlers entering with the blind average after 9 games have been bowled.
8. Teams will use average minus 10 for absent bowlers. In case of a regular member absence and the 5th and 6th bowlers do not bowl, the regular members average minus 10 will be used.
9. In case of a tie in the same division for 1st place at the end of the 14th week, a 1 game roll-off will take place immediately after the completion of league play to determine a divisional champion.
10. In case of a tie in standings during the season, the team with the higher average will assume the higher position.
11. The 1st place teams from each division will bowl a 3 game roll-off on the 15th week to determine overall champion and the winners of the 1st place awards. Roll-off winner will be determined by points.
12. A minimum of 2 bowlers must be present on any scheduled night to constitute a legal line up. A bowler has until 7:45 pm to be able to bowl. If not present by 7:45 pm, they must wait until the next game.
13. Make-up games must be arranged through the Secretary and the team captains involved. All make-ups must be bowled at least 2 days before the next night of bowling. Teams will be allowed to bowl unopposed. If teams are unable to make-up games, they will forfeit all games for that night.
14. Any member resigning from the league must give the Secretary and their team captain 2 weeks notice in writing. Resigning bowlers will be responsible for the bowling fees during this 2 week period unless replaced immediately.
15. Any bowler more than 2 weeks behind in bowling fees will not be allowed to bowl until the shortage is paid. Shortages will be deducted from the team prize money.
16. Team captains are responsible for collecting team's monies, totaling score cards, providing a score keeper and other duties listed by USBC. They are also responsible for putting FULL names on team money envelopes and the amount each person pays for that week.
17. To be eligible for any league awards a bowler must have bowled at least 8 weeks of the season.
18. Any disputes between teams or individuals will be settled by the league board of directors.
